Essential Job Duties and Responsibilities

Your primary duty as a Driver Trainee, which we call a Logistics Specialist I, is to deliver materials to a customer's place of business or to a job site. The primary vehicle used to accomplish this duty is a 24-foot flatbed straight truck with a gross weight exceeding 26,001 lbs. A hydraulic boom or articulating crane is attached to a truck to accomplish the delivery. You will operate within a maximum of a 200-mile radius of your home branch, with deliveries originating and ending at the branch (no deliveries result in an overnight stay). You may have to load and unload trucks using a forklift, Moffett and/or other mechanical equipment.

- You will be safe.
- Drive a commercial vehicle in compliance with all DOT regulations.
- You will act as a leader for job site safety.
- You will repetitively lift building products that weigh up to 100 lbs. on a continuous basis.
- Capture pictures of all building products delivered
